

Curriculum for **Crash Courses**

About GLS: Founded in 1983, GLS German Language School is located centrally in Berlin and welcomes ca. 1400 students every year from up to 60 nations. GLS is accredited locally by the Berlin Senate, and internationally by the Swedish Ministry of Education. GLS, like the Goethe Institut, is an official testing center for TestDaF and telc B1.

Intensive courses train German for everyday communication and are complemented by afternoon activities and weekend excursions.

1. Lessons per week

30 lessons of German classes:

- 20 lessons / week à 45 min. international groups with max. 12 students per class
- 10 lessons / week à 45 min. one to one tuition

2-3 hours seminar on German culture or a German movie with teacher introduction every Tuesday 3 half-day excursions in Berlin with GLS guide

1 full-day excursion in Berlin or to Hamburg, Dresden, Leipzig, Potsdam with GLS guide

In addition to this, students have ample opportunity to practice their German with their German hosts: GLS arranges accommodation in Berlin households - single room, with a choice of self catering, bed & breakfast or half board.

Students usually arrive on Sundays on GLS Campus or they meet their German host, and start classes Monday morning with a placement test, helping us to place them in one of 7 levels:
