

Curriculum for **Standard Courses**

About GLS: Founded in 1983, GLS German Language School is located centrally in Berlin and welcomes ca. 1800 students every year from up to 60 nations. GLS is accredited locally by the Berlin Senate, and internationally by the Swedish Ministry of Education. GLS, like the Goethe Institut, is an official testing center for TestDaF and telc B1.

Standard courses train German for everyday communication and are complemented by afternoon activities and weekend excursions.

In addition to this, students have ample opportunity to practice their German with their German hosts: GLS arranges accommodation in Berlin households - single room, with a choice of self catering, bed & breakfast or half board.

Students usually arrive on Sundays on GLS Campus or meet their German host, and start classes Monday morning with a placement test, helping us to place them in one of 6 levels:
